Visit / registration

EuroSkills 2021 is an international event. For security reasons and also due to the COVID-19 situation, all visitors must be registered without exception. To ensure safe visitor management there are three different time slots for each competition day (23rd, 24th & 25th of September) for which visitors can register:

// Time Slot 1: 08:30am – 11:30am

// Time Slot 2: 11:30am – 02:30pm

// Time Slot 3: 02:30pm – 05:30pm

Individual registration

The selection of a time slot is mandatory as well as the provision of the required personal data in the registration form. Visitors can register for more than one time slot if they want to spend the whole day at the competition area. After the registration is completed, the entry ticket will be sent to the specified e-mail address and can be presented at the on-site access control either digitally or printed out.

Group registration

For groups of 10 persons or more, there is a separate registration form to make the visit with the whole group or school class at EuroSkills 2021 run smoothly.

The desired day and time slot can also be selected and the required data of the persons or students and the accompanying persons must be entered according to the form. It is possible to book several time slots for the same group/the same person. In this case, the registration must be repeated for another time slot. After the registration is completed, the entrance tickets will be sent to the specified e-mail address for the group collectively (personalised tickets) and can be presented at the access control on site either digitally or printed out.
